ORDINANCE NO. 2012- 06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 CHAPTER 3  
OF THE LODA VILLAGE CODE  
(Animal Control)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Loda, Iroquois County, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** That Section 3-3-4, of Chapter 3 of the Title 3 of the Village Code of Loda be and the same is amended hereby so that hereafter of said shall be and read as follows:

E- Poultry:

Chickens: up to 12 adult chickens and 12 Pullets are allowed to be kept for personal use. Chickens must be kept in an enclosed building and pen. Owner is responsible for noise and odor. Droppings and bedding must be kept clean and disposed of properly. Any structure erected to house chickens must meet building ordinance requirements. No Slaughtering or Butchering animals in public view.

G- Rabbits:

Up to 12 rabbits adults and babies maybe kept for personal use. Rabbits must be kept in an enclosed pen. All droppings and bedding must be disposed of properly. Any structure erected to house rabbits must meet building ordinance requirements. No slaughtering or butchering of animals in public view.

H- Treatment of Animals

All animals kept within Village Limits must be treated in a humane manner. That must be sheltered and cared for in proper manner

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication, as provided by law.
