The Village of Loda Board of Trustees held a Special Meeting on September 8, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. at the Village Hall for to extend the contract for oil and chipping also to discuss is the type of gravel to be used . Present were President Carol Arseneau, Clerk Sandra Zalaker, Trustees : Jon Boone, Roy Hillgendorf, Richard Manzke, Patricia Allen . Not present were Ronda Breeden, Cathy Tittle and Myles Reck. Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by President Arseneau. Engineer Tom Overmeyer was present to speak. He had received 2 letters from Robert Gray of Grays Material Service, one who was contracted to do oil and chipping of Village streets. First letter asks for a request for extension of (15) fifteen days on the completion for the project. Second letter is for to change from crushed gravel to crushed limestone. The board discussed the difference between crushed gravel , (it is clean , non dusty, and sticks to roads better), and crushed limestone (is finer , dusty, and does not stick to roads as good). If they used crushed limestone there would be dust in air and on cars, houses when traveled on , messy. Crushed gravel is washed out so as to not have much dust in it . Fisher just had theirs done with crushed gravel and are very nice roads. President Arseneau brought in a sample of the crushed gravel to show board. Trustee Allen motioned not to accept the crushed limestone instead of the crushed gravel. Seconded by Trustee Boone. Roll call was taken all trustees present voted not to accept . (4 yes votes and 0 no votes) Motion carried not to accept crushed limestone. Trustee Allen motioned to reject the extension of 15 days by Grays Material Services . Seconded by Trustee Boone . Roll call was taken all trustees said Yes to reject the extension . (4 yes votes and 0 no votes). Motion carried to reject the extension.

Trustee Hillgendorf wanted to know what were going to do about bank parking lot? President Arseneau said she would talk to United Paving , Polson, and the Bank about their parking lot and see what to do .

Trustee Boone motioned to adjourn seconded by Trustee Allen all were in favor . Motion approved meeting ended at 5:55 p.m..
