ORDINANCE 2024-01

**AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE MODIFICATION OF WATER
RATES FOR THE VILLAGE OF LODA WATER SYSTEM AND
AMENDING SECTION 4-2-1 OF THE VILLAGE CODE AND PRIOR
ORDINANCES 2008-06 AND 2021-01**

Be it ordained by the President and Village Board of the Village of Loda, Count of Iroquois, and State of Illinois that Section 4-2-1 of the Village Code pertaining to service rates and charges for the Village Water System be and is hereby amended to read in words and figures as follows:

SECTION 1:

§ 4-2-1

1. The sum of \$32.00 basic minimum fee for each and every connection to the Village Water System.
2.
 - a. The amount of \$10.25 per thousand gallons used in addition to said basic minimal fee through April 30th, 2024
 - b. The amount of \$10.50 per thousand gallons used in addition to said basic minimal fee commencing May 1st, 2024
 - c. The amount of \$10.75 per thousand gallons used in addition to said basic minimal fee commencing May 1st, 2025
 - d. The amount of \$11.00 per thousand gallons used in addition to said basic minimal fee commencing May 1st, 2026
3. For each fire hydrant, a charge of \$4.00 per billing period is hereby imposed commencing with the next regular billing period.

SECTION 2:

All prior ordinances and parts thereof of the Village of Loda are hereby repealed and otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3:

A copy of this ordinance should be duly posted pursuant to statute and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage, approval, and posting as provided by law.

SECTION 4:

Billing of the rates established by this Ordinance shall commence with the next regular billing cycle after said passage and approval except as otherwise provided within the text of this Ordinance.
